



It is the goal of the Los Alamitos Education Foundation (LAEF) to provide a positive, safe and secure classroom-learning environment for all students. To ensure that all students have equal access to success and a sense of well-being, all students are subject to the following behavior contract.

I, _____, understand that my child, _____, is subject to the following provisions while attending any courses offered through LAEF.

1. All students shall respect authority. This shall include conformance to classroom rules, teacher directives, and those provisions of civil law that apply to the conduct of juveniles.
2. Student conduct shall reflect consideration for the rights and privileges of others, including cooperation with all members of the educational community.
3. All students shall participate in an inclusive environment at LAEF. Respect for the unique abilities and traits of others is expected, and no form of harassment, discrimination, or retaliation against fellow students or LAEF staff shall be tolerated.
4. High personal standards of courtesy, decency, morality, clean language, honesty and respectful relationships with others shall be maintained. Respect for real and personal property, pride in the student's work, and achievement within the student's ability shall be expected of each student.

(Please initial the following in agreement)

_____ I understand that my child shall be picked up at the posted ending time for the course or I will be charged \$1 per minute, or fraction thereof, beginning 5 minutes after the posted end time.

_____ I understand that if my child has to be removed from the classroom during the scheduled course time due to inappropriate behavior, it will be my responsibility to pick him/her up earlier than the scheduled ending time of the course.

_____ I understand that if my child engages in any physical aggression, displays behavior that LAEF feels threatens the safety or wellbeing of other students in any way, or has to be removed from a classroom on more than one occasion due to behavior or noncompliance, my course fee is forfeited, and my child will no longer be able to participate in any LAEF courses during the current session.

_____ I understand that participating in LAEF courses is a privilege and it is expected that every student will come to learn and support other students in their quest for enrichment. If my child cannot interact in a respectful manner with all members in the class, or is otherwise disruptive to the learning environment, my child may forfeit the right to continue in the course. In that case, my course fee is forfeited, and my child will no longer be able to participate in any LAEF courses during the current session.
