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Another Successful Session of LAEF After-School Classes!

(Los Alamitos, CA) – The Los Alamitos Education Foundation’s fall after-school classes and sports clinics are coming to an end, but the enrichment that children have experienced will last a lifetime! Nearly 600 students participated in more than 50 classes and clinics, from Art Explorations (pictured below) to Beyblades Physics to Driver’s Education, offered on campus immediately following the end of the school day. Fifteen more classes were available to students this session as compared to last spring’s LAEF classes.

Classes were offered at each school site in the district with our fall theme as “The Great Outdoors.” Elementary students explored the elements of art using natural materials, learned about the science of “being green” through recycling and composting, and immersed themselves in Spanish, learning new vocabulary for nature and outdoor activities! Middle School students focused on developing their sports skills, and LAHS students had the opportunity to learn critical driving skills!

LAEF art teacher Pauline Richter says, “It is a pleasure to provide enrichment classes to elementary students. There is so much to learn during the school day and I am happy that I can work with children to bring weekly lessons to increase creativity and artistic expression.”
