### Surfeo Safari (Spanish)

We're going to be learning about the surf and the ocean; animals and other living organisms in their habitat. Focus is on building Spanish vocabulary and conversational dialogue.

Children will learn a new language in a fun total immersion setting using stories, games, music and crafts.
