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LAEF Donates \$22,500 to Los AI USD Middle & High Schools!

(Los Alamitos, CA) – The Los Alamitos Education Foundation (LAEF) was proud to donate \$22,500 to the Los Alamitos Unified School District’s two middle schools and the high school this fall. Each school received \$7,500 to support STEAM instruction and activities on their campuses. By providing these funds LAEF continues to help extend the STEAM Initiative (science, technology, engineering, the arts and math) across the district. These funds will be used to purchase supplies and materials for the Science Olympiad Programs, and for the new 6th grade STEM classes and existing Project Lead the Way classes at the middle schools. LAHS funds will also be used to support the new sections of Computer Science classes, the expanded Science Olympiad teams, and the Robotics Team.

This week, LAEF Executive Director Carrie Logue presented a check to McAuliffe Middle School Principal Annie Allen, Oak Middle School Principal Erin Kominsky, and Los Alamitos High School Principal Dr. Brandon Martinez. All three principals are very excited about the opportunity to continue to develop and expand the STEAM programs for the students at their schools.
