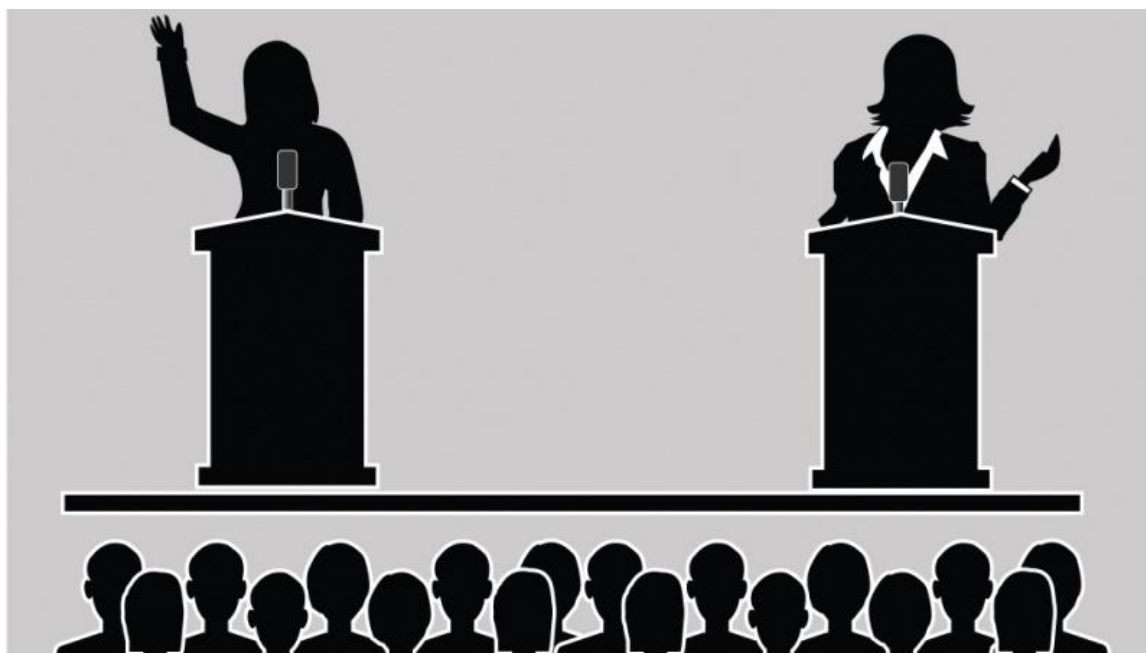


McAuliffe's Debate Team

Team Coach/Advisor: Dr. Arnold Weintraub, currently a substitute teacher for McAuliffe who has over 12 years of experience coaching debate teams (including a previous winning LAHS team) will be our Coach for this debate season. As this is our first year, it will be a learning process for everyone, and we are looking forward to a fun and exciting program!

When will we meet: The Debate Team Fall sessions will meet afterschool at McAuliffe on Wednesdays from 2:15-3:45 **starting on January 16, 2019** through May 1.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST? – This afterschool club will cost \$240 per student. *LAEF has paid for registration for the team for the year.* Thus, attendance at OCDL events is optional and there will be no extra fee for participating.

COMPETITION: McAuliffe's team will also participate in the Orange County Debate League (OCDL), whose mission is "To promote academic and personal growth in local youth through the sport of debate." In the OCDL, students compete in regular tournaments throughout the school year where they are eligible to earn awards as individuals, as a team, and as a school. In addition, league administrators and coaches offer educational workshops and several learning opportunities throughout the year.
