Robotics

This class provides students with engaging hands-on explorations of computer science, technology, engineering and mathematical fields using robots.

Students will build and program real-life robotic solutions using motors, sensors, batteries, connectors, and various structural elements. Through this engaging program, students will show creativity, use teamwork, and strengthen their skills in logic, math, problem solving, and deduction. Intro to Guitar

This class is designed as an introduction to guitar for new learners. Students will learn the basic aspects of music theory, including western notes, what a scale is, what a major/minor cord is and what keys are.
