Registration:

All registration will be completed online. Registration will be on a first come, first served basis. *A minimum enrollment of 8 kids is required to be able to run each camp.*

Multi-Camp Discount:

Multi-camp discounts are available! Purchase your 1st camp, then receive 10% off the 2nd camp and 15% off any camp thereafter. Discount applied to family or child.

Discount applied to LAEF's Enrichment Camps only. The discounts do not apply to Los Al USD Head Coaches' Summer Sports Camps, LAUSD Directors' Summer Camps in the Arts and the High School Health class. Registration is on hold for these camps.

Scholarships:

Limited partial scholarships are available on a first come, first served basis. Applications are available at www.LAEF4kids.org/scholarships.

Late Pick Up:

Children must be picked up from their classroom at the stated camp end time or the parent/guardian will be charge \$15 for each 15-minute increment beginning at 5 minutes after camp ends.

Behavior Expectations:

It is the goal of the Los Alamitos Education Foundation (LAEF) to provide a positive, safe, and secure environment for all children. To ensure that all kids have equal access to success and a sense of well-being during LAEF programs, we expect that child behave appropriately. Participating in Enrichment Camps is a privilege and if a child has to be removed from a cohort on more than one occasion, the camp fee will be forfeited, and the child will no longer be able to participate.

Refund Policy:

Tuition is non-refundable unless LAEF cancels the camp due to the minimum enrollment not being met or due to precautions related to COVID-19. Should a child miss camp due to illness, a prorated refund/credit will be provided upon parent request. Aside from illness, if your child misses camp or withdraws before the end of the session, you are still responsible for the full fees of the session.

Transportation:

Bus transportation will not be offered between LAEF Enrichment Camps and Kids Korner at Lee Elementary.
