



Guidelines for Enrichment Camps – August 3-14, 2020

HEALTHY HYGIENE PRACTICES

Hand washing will be taught, modeled and reinforced in each camp cohort. Kids will be reminded to use tissues or sneeze into elbows, and to avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth. Signage will be posted.

Soap, paper towels, tissues and hand sanitizer will be supplied in each classroom.

Face coverings will be required for parent/guardian and children during arrival and departure from campus. Parents/guardians are required to walk their child to and pick them up from the classroom area. All staff must wear a face covering, and they will be mandatory where physical distancing cannot be maintained.

While with their cohort, child face coverings should be worn. During outdoor recreation and snack time, face coverings will be removed, and kids will be distanced. Please send a labeled plastic or paper bag with your child each day, so that their face covering can be safely stored when removed. Children will be reminded to not touch face coverings and to wash them frequently.

MAINTAINING HEALTHY ENVIRONMENTS

Custodial staff will clean and disinfect each classroom and high-use areas each day. Teachers will be provided with disinfecting wipes for additional cleaning needs. Drinking fountains will not be available for use; kids must bring filled water bottles from home.

Children must bring their own supplies in a labeled pencil box/bag – pencils, eraser, crayons/markers/colored pencils, scissors, and glue stick. Items cannot be shared. The teacher will provide consumable items, such as worksheets, lined paper, construction paper, etc. If a shared item is deemed necessary, it will be cleaned and disinfected between uses.

Outdoor activities will be by cohort, organized and strictly supervised by the teacher (no “free play”), and will limit the use of playground equipment. Any outdoor equipment will not be shared between cohorts and will be sanitized between uses.

MAINTAINING HEALTHY OPERATIONS

Children will remain with only their cohort, with their teacher, and in their classroom or designated outdoor area throughout the camp. Upon teacher request, one volunteer will be assigned to each classroom and will remain with that cohort only throughout the camp. Cohort size will be 8-15 kids, depending on enrollment.

Classrooms will be arranged so that six feet is between each child's seat. To minimize face-to-face contact, all seating will face the front of the classroom. Physical guides (signage, tape on floors) will be provided to promote social distancing.

Kids are encouraged to pack a snack, along with a water bottle. Children may not share food or water.

Several designated "health screening stations" will be set up, utilizing multiple campus entrances, and must be visited upon arrival each day. Temperatures will be taken with no-touch thermometers and symptom questions will be asked. Arrival and departure will take place over a 15-minute period to minimize contact and allow distancing.

Any staff, children, parents and/or guardians who feel ill, have symptoms or had direct contact with a positive case of COVID-19 must not come on campus. Prorated refunds will be made available. Symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell.

LAEF COVID-19 Waiver of Liability

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

The Los Alamitos Education Foundation (LAEF) cannot prevent you [or your child(ren)] from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while utilizing LAEF's services. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. I hereby choose to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 for myself and/or my children in order to utilize LAEF's services and enter Los Alamitos Unified campuses. These services are of such value to me [and/or to my children,] that I accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to utilize LAEF's services in person.

WAIVER OF LAWSUIT/LIABILITY: I hereby forever release and waive my right to bring suit against LAEF and its officers, directors, managers, employees, or other representatives in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to utilizing LAEF's services and premises. I understand that this waiver means I give up my right to bring any claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claim I may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen.

CHOICE OF LAW: I understand and agree that the law of the State of California will apply to this contract.
