LAEF hosted a special event in May to recognize and celebrate the Los Alamitos Unified School District's Teachers of the Year. LAEF was proud to bring back this celebration that had not taken place since before the pandemic. A total of nine outstanding teachers were honored at the event, one from each district school. Each teacher, nominated by their peers, was recognized for their dedication, creativity, and passion in the classroom. Each school principal spoke about the teacher's exceptional contributions and the positive impact they have on their students and school communities. Then, each teacher was presented their award and gift, and gave an acceptance speech.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT INSTITUTE - LARGEST EVER!

Each year, LAEF's Summer Enrichment Institute (SEI) is an essential part of summer for Los Al parents and students, offering fun and educational learning opportunities for students in grades TK-12. This year, we held SEI at Rossmoor Elementary School and it was LAEF's largest attended to date. LAEF's first session of SEI was launched on June 20 and Session 2 began on July 3rd, offering over 144 fun and academic enrichment classes to more than 680 students.

AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM CONTINUES TO GROW & THRIVE!

- 1,422 students enrolled in Fall classes across all nine schools!
- 225 of those students are enrolled through the Extended Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP).
- 16 free virtual elementary World Language classes in 4 languages.
- In 2023, approximately 240 scholarships were issued to students in need totaling over \$31,000!

LAEF awarded \$74,200 for STEAM Grants (science, technology, engineering, the arts, and math) during the 2022-23 school year. Each of the district's nine schools received a grant based on applications from school principals to support anything STEAM related, such as curriculum, supplies, technology and/or staff salaries.
